T&SC16-001 - Apologies, Acceptance of apologies and declarations of interests

T&SC16-002 - To approve the minutes from the meeting held on 2 November 2015

Resolved: The minutes of 2 November 2015 were approved and signed

T&SC16-002 - Public Participation – to accept questions and comments from members of the public and councillors with a prejudicial interest

T&SC16-003 - Business Matters

- a) Risk Assessments
 - BMX track has been flattened and will be rebuilt on a new, more appropriate site.
 - It was **resolved** to contract with ECDC £20 per site per visit for monthly inspections. Proposed by Cllr Dodson, seconded by Cllr Massey, all agreed
 - Streetlight in Carpond Lane – could be improved by cutting back the overhanging conifer
 - Recreation field – rubber matting under the play equipment needs steam cleaning as it is green and slippery. Dave Maltby did this last year for a cost of £100. It was **resolved** that he be asked to do it again this year. Proposed by Cllr Forsyth, seconded by Cllr Hennessy, all agreed.
 - Cllr Forsyth will investigate any improvements that can be made to the pedestrian crossing to reduce the number of near accidents

T&SC16-004 - Correspondence not covered in Business Matters

- a) CCC – re- Local Highways Improvement Bid – the bid for improvements to the crossing in Car Pond Lane was successful will probably implemented during the summer holidays. The schemes will now be drawn up. A bid for next year needs to be considered
- b) ECDC – Transport Strategy for East Cambridgeshire – consultation is now open
- c) PCSO is now Jonathan Hall. He has been in contact with Cllr Dodson who updated him on the known issues in the village. A meeting of the working group will be held in the next couple of months. Members of the public are to be encouraged to report any problems to the police.
