Update on Broadway pavement application. (a)

> Councillor Forsyth confirmed the work had been completed on the pavement at Berristead except marking and caution children crossing. He will notify costs as to the Parish Council as soon as possible. Some aspects need changing as they are not aesthetically pleasing. will also send a list of works due to be carried out on other areas of the Village.

(b) Update on Traffic Survey.

Councillor Forsyth confirmed had been given up to £1500 to spend on the survey, has sent all relevant information and currently waiting for a response. He is chasing this and will be having a consultation on car pond lane scheme turning circle, widening of road etc.

(c) Risk assessments including safety of trees

The review of risk assessments and committees responsible were discussed, with the financial aspects being dealt with by the finance committee and the possibility of the others being dealt with by the Traffic and Safety Committee and Ground, Minor Works and Litter Committee. It was also confirmed that the new playground at Berristead and BMX track should be included in the next ROSPA report.

Resolved: - It was proposed by Councillor Forsyth and seconded by Councillor Dodson that all risk assessments, apart from the financial assessments, be looked at by the Traffic and Safety committee, and raised again, once the co-option of Councillors had been adopted at the next Council meeting. All in favour.

Action points:- Clerk to add Risk Assessments to next Agenda and notify Playsafety that the new playground should be included in the next ROSPA report.

(d) Update on Police Community Liaison meeting

Councillor Dodson confirmed that a meeting had been arranged for the above, and she had contacted the St Peters Hall Caretaker, Social Club, residents etc. to see if there were any items that they wished to be raised apart from those on the Agenda of problems with drugs in different areas, car parking on pavements, and anti-social behaviour on playground at Berristead etc.
